Retest donor with a new device if you get an invalid result.	<b>NEGATIVE:</b> Any reddish-purple line (even a faint or broken line) visible at 5 minutes in the test area (along with a valid control) is a negative result. Example above: all five test results are negative, and test is Valid.	PRESUMPTIVE POSITIVE: The absence of a line in the test area (along with a valid control) is a presumptive positive result. Example above: the OP (Opiate) test is presumptive positive and the test is Valid.
